
HRH Queen Elizabeth II

It has officially been announced that the Queen's funeral will take place at Westminster Abbey on Monday, September 19th at 11am. <u>Schools will be closed on the day of the Queen's funeral</u>. This will allow children to watch the televised service and pay their respects.

KS2 SATS

A huge well done to our Year 6 2022 leaver's who performed so well in their KS2 SATS \odot

The school was in line with or exceeded National KS2 SATS figures in all areas. Notable points:

- Reading, Writing and Maths (RWM): 12% higher than National figure
- Maths: 15% higher than National figure
- Reading: 12% higher than National figure
- Greater Depth: 43% Maths, 43% Reading, 43% Grammar, Punctuation & Spelling

Pupil Premium Funding - IMPORTANT

Pupil premium is additional funding for publicly funded schools in England to help raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils and close the gap between them and their peers. This means that YOUR child may be entitled to a quite considerable amount of funding that can be used within school to support their learning.

This extra funding can really make a difference to your child's achievements and for that reason we are asking that all Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 parents register online at <u>www.hertsdirect.org/freeschoolmeals</u>.

Please note that children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are provided with free meals. However, this does not mean that you are already registered for Pupil Premium. To gain the extra Pupil Premium funding for your child you must register by using the above URL or link. Thank you.

Medication

Please ensure that your children's medicines that are stored at school are within the best before date.

Asthma – If your child has asthma please try to provide the school with two asthma inhalers and ensure you have provided the school with written permission to use the Emergency Asthma Inhalers should they be required.

Attendance

There is clear evidence of a link between persistent lateness/poor attendance at school and low levels of achievement. Please help us and your child by ensuring their attendance remains above 96%, allowing them to achieve their potential.

Holidays during term time

Unfortunately, the school is unable to authorise any holidays that are requested during term times. These absences will be recorded in the register as unauthorised absence.

Wet/cold weather clothes

Please ensure your child has a coat and outdoor shoes in school each day.

Stapleford Primary School Lottery
