Other tasks for the day	History Task Worms have existed for around 600 million years. Can you create a bug hotel in your back garden. They particularly like there to be lots of nooks and crannies to explore. Using what you have found out, design and make your own minibeast hotel. Then fill your hotel with lots of natural materials, such as dry leaves, grass, stones, straw, pine cones, old logs or moss. + Daily reading (30 minutes) Daily exercise (30 minutes)	Art Task- Make a model or picture of a minibeast. Choose a minibeast that you would like to make, draw or create. You could make it trickier, by designing it with moving parts. Think about the legs, wings or body and how it moves. Design and plan your model first, think about how you will make the parts move, for example a ladybird with wings that move side to side.
